### 01. Guideline

This guideline is intended to establish an incident response procedure for incidents requiring tactical channels

### 02. Procedures:

#### 2.1 Incident Dispatches

Battalion chiefs will not complete a formal roll call on the tactical channel.

- Battalion chief announces response on assigned tactical channel (i.e. "Battalion 2 on B6")
- Fire Dispatch notifies battalion chief when all units are responding and of relevant information updates (i.e. "BC2, all units are responding, one person reported inside structure")
- The battalion chief should not reread information on MDC and should only announce pertinent information
- Responding resources announce delays and notify of non-standard staffing levels (i.e. "E10 responding from Power Inn Rd and Folsom Blvd")
- Out of county agencies, i.e. West Sacramento FD, El Dorado Hills FD, Roseville FD, etc., announce their response on the assigned tactical channel (i.e. "West Sac E44 responding on B6")


#### 2.2 Greater Alarm Incidents

Second alarm companies will not complete a formal roll call on the assigned staging channel.

- Primary pre-designated staging channels are A11 or B11; secondarily, A12 or B12 are used
- The first engine on the second alarm assignment is staging area manager (STAM)
- The first engine on the second alarm announces that they are on the staging channel and identifies/confirming staging location (i.e. "E106 on A11, staging will be at Watt and Fulton")
- Arriving resources shall announce their presence at the staging location
- Out of county agencies are not expected to become the STAM; for example, if a West Sacramento Fire unit on the second alarm is listed first, then the second listed engine becomes STAM
- STAM announces the staging location for subsequent alarm resources
- During high-rise operations the STAM should announce they are on the assigned staging channel


