  - Captain- "Engine I Captain"
  - Engineer- "Engine I Engineer"
  - Firefighter- "Engine I Nozzle"
  - Firefighter- "Engine I Back-up"
  - Firefighter- "Engine I Control"
- Truck
  - Captain- "Truck I Captain"
  - Engineer- "Truck I Engineer"
  - Firefighter- "Truck I Saw"
  - Firefighter- "Truck I Tools"
  - Firefighter- "Truck I Outside Vent"
- Medic
  - Firefighter- "Medic I Irons"
  - Firefighter- "Medic I Control"
- Battalion Chiefs should use their numerical battalion designator- "Battalion I"
- Administrative staff should utilize their assigned four-digit numerical designator- "2201"


